Unit 2 - <u>Grammar</u>: modal verbs can/could/be able to; question formation; so/ neither/ nor. <u>Functions</u>: talking about skills & abilities; asking and answering questions. <u>Vocabulary</u>: personality; countries and nationalities; describing people. <u>Focus on accuracy</u>: I can talk about habits, activities & abilities; I can use pronouns accurately; I can use numbers accurately. <u>Focus on fluency</u>: I can talk about a painting.

Unit 3 - <u>Grammar</u>: past simple; modal verbs could; used to/would; either ...or... <u>Functions</u>: talking about the past; talking about past habits & routines. <u>Vocabulary</u>: review: describing people; actions; digital verbs.

Unit 4 - <u>Grammar</u>: past simple vs past continuous; zero conditional; imperative conditional; -ing form & infinitive; attitude adverbs; even. <u>Functions</u>: talking about activities in the past; talking about conditions. <u>Vocabulary</u>: health; disasters. <u>Skills forum</u>: The great escape (reading & speaking; listening & writing); <u>Focus on accuracy</u>: I can use a variety of verb forms correctly; I can compare & contrast; I can listen accurately. <u>Focus on fluency</u>: I can give a talk.

Unit 5 – <u>Grammar</u>: modal verb must; semi-modal verb have to; needn't; modal verb should; semi-modal verb ought to; be allowed to; like + -ing + infinitive; strong adjectives. <u>Functions</u>: giving instructions; making suggestions & recommendations. <u>Vocabulary</u>: review: talking about holidays; landscape; word formation. <u>Communication forum</u>: giving advice.

Unit 6 – <u>Grammar</u>: comparatives & superlatives; some/any/enough; comparative adverbs; countable & uncountable nouns; defining quantity; so/such; prefixes un-/-in-. <u>Functions</u>: comparing and contrasting; talking about quantity. <u>Vocabulary</u>: British & America English; everyday things; tourism. <u>Skills forum</u>: gap year adventure (reading & listening; speaking & writing). <u>Focus on accuracy</u>: I can use a range of verb forms; I can use articles accurately. <u>Focus on fluency</u>: I can describe places.

Unit 7- <u>Grammar</u>: present perfect; for; since; present perfect + just/ already /yet/ so far; present perfect vs past simple. <u>Functions</u>: talking about experiences & duration; talking about recent events. <u>Vocabulary</u>: work activities; academic subjects.
