MODULES and partial ref to LEARNING UNITS	CONVERSATION TOPICS AND LANGUAGE SKILLS
Module 0.	Listening comprehension on the Soothing Power of Books Part II BBC 6 mins. Daily activities having a soothing effect on us; new words: romance, novel, crime stories and love comedies/stories. Conversation classes' approach and learning methodology on the topic: 'our planet'. Main abbreviations; Useful expressions: depict something; 'to make acquaintance' and 'it takes'. Words from unit 18 plus new expressions such as: 'draw the curtains, having a duvet or sheets & blankets etc.
Module1. Planet Earth Ref Units 5-7-8-11; upper-inter. unit 44	Geographical traits of our planet: reading comprehension and focus pronunciation. Regions and cardinal points and their adjectival plus compound forms. Weather conditions and physical places.
COMPETENCE BUILDING 1	Students' presentations on a chosen place, country or city of cultural interest with hints at the physical traits of the territory and cultural elements: Crete, London and N.Y. Ireland, Venice Egypt, New York, Los Angeles, Paris and St. Frances' wood, Krakow, Mallorca St. Domingo, Switzerland, an Italian region: Umbria, Greece, Stockholm, Brazil
Module 2. City and Country Life; Travel and journeys partial ref units 26/27:	Expansion of city/country life vocab and conversation practice; pros and cons of city or country life. Class google doc editing and sharing. How to talk about travelling: phrasal verbs and common collocations.
Module 3. The places where we live. Partial ref unit 17. Indoor spaces.	Kinds of houses and their location: short video contribution as attached in Didattica. 'Kinds of houses': detached, semi-detached, terraced (townhouses), cottages, blocks of flats etc. Differences among them.
Module 4. Talking around money Ref. Unit 19	Listening Comprehension on BBC 6 mins video "Is being thrifty a virtue" - a short history of the word 'thrif'. First attempts at commenting and paraphrasing; the virtue of being thrifty. Free commenting on thrift- personal critical opinions on consumerism; BBC video watching, vocab focusing and recapping on 'retail therapy'. Places where to go shopping: outdoor and indoor places. Shopping habits. Sharing of personal opinions on on-line purchases.

Module 5. Fashion and spending habits; ref. units 22, 23	Shopping in malls or street markets - Fashion and buying clothes: shopping habits and the use of 'to be likely to do sthg'. Shopping: how are products arranged? Where is it more likely to find all what you need under one roof? Where is it more likely that people haggle for things?
Module 6 6.1 FOOD 6.2 RECIPES	Warm-up on eating habits and trends (vegetarians and vegans); Cooking and cooking processes/methods (boiling, simmering etc); partial ref units 24-25 plus kinds of salads (octopus, potatoes etc) New vocab: to stew, rotten food, unripe fruit, beverages and fizzy drinks. Reading comprehension on kinds of food with a 'bad reputation'. Vocab expansion. Conversation practice on unit 24 (likelihood, chores etc.): extra vocab: to peel, almond -salmon (silent l) homophones (mussels/muscles), kinds of salad, vegetables and fruit. Cooking techniques (boiling, baking, grilling, simmering. - Quiz on eating habits; reading comprehension on 'the unsuspected benefits of some foods'. Sample sharing of a recipe; kitchen tools; translating recipes (BBC video contribution shared).
COMPETENCE BUILDING 2 THE REGULATIVE TEXT: RECIPES	Recipes and methods: international Cornish pasty and the Crème Caramel. Listening comprehension practice. Reading and Listening Comprehension of a Turkey recipe, Listening Comprehension on Creme Caramel and on a gravy sauce for meat dishes. International cuisine: The Cornish Pasty. Listening Comprehension and filling the gaps exercises.
COMPETENCE BUILDING 3 THE REGULATIVE TEXT: RECIPES – Students 'presentations	Presentation of the chosen recipes: Recipes' sharing, vocab expansion and conversation practice upon the BBC short video on 'translating recipes'. The chocolate cake, polenta and cinnamon rolls, The Bulgarian Mousaka,, the Fruit Tart, the Chocolate cake etc..
Module 7. The Regulative texts: road signs, signs and notices.	Use of 'suggest and recommend. Regulative language: Transport means, fares and stations, platforms etc. Commonly collocated verbs.
Language – going deeper	Common mispronunciations of vowels and diphthongs' sounds; silent consonants; the different behaviour of the diphthong 'ea'
School Education ref units 31-34	Educational systems: certifications and different school systems, acronyms: GCSE, NEETs. The VABR model (link shared): debating on the personal learning techniques.

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
