MODULES and partial ref to Units	CONVERSATION TOPICS AND LANGUAGE SKILLS
1. Education and school life. Ref units 31-34	Studying in Italy or abroad. New terms: enrol, apply for, vocational vs professional. Universities in UK - FOCUS VOCAB; kinds of courses and admission procedure. Unis' rankings in UK. New vocab: being misunderstood, willing to Reading and Listening Comprehension on Unis. Article from Speak Up 'Studying at a British Uni'.
Language: going deeper	Silent consonants: 'h', 'k', 'l', 'b' and 'r'. Pronunciation and mispronunciation: common mistakes. Vowel sounds and diphthongs with different pronunciations: 'ea', 'ei'.
2. Professions and jobs: ref units 35-40	Conversation practice around 'The Causative' matched with professions and professionals. Partial ref. unit 35. Bbc short video watching on 'The Causative' s expansion in tenses and forms. Economics jargon Part I 'Running a company'. Finance and business jargon: going deeper: Wall Street crash in 1929. Extra vocab: mortgage, financial crash, inflation rates etc. Pros and cons of a chosen profession: infinitive, general structures to refer to global thinking. Sentences' building check: the Infinitive used as a noun in the spoken practice. BBC 6 mins video on hustle jobs: new vocab and structure 'get accustomed to doing sthg'. BBC 6 mins video on working for oneself: self-sabotage, creeping thoughts, agile/flexible jobs vs a fixed rota of tasks, to become a grind, to work the social ladder up in the same business, to adapt to an ever-changing world, to find sthg. Petrifying. Consumerism- mass society: focus vocab based on Duran Duran's lyrics of 'Paper Gods'. BBC 'The Art of Conversation'- Listening Comprehension: spoken practice upon. Conversation practice around unit 67-68. Pair work. Conversation practice based on functional language: expressing opinions on society and current 'hot potatoes' issues.
COMPETENCE BUILDING	The Causative and the professions: file - collective writing; interviews to professionals. Debating: TED TALK show: mental health issues at school by H. Hardcastle.

Energy saving at home: strategies and advances in home appliances Recapping on electricity saving methods; new vocab: consumption, exploit, appliances, energy loss, insulation, sensible uses, prevent from. Context building practice with the new vocab around the environment; introduction to the next level reading comprehension practice towards B2+.
